

## International Women's Month Project

It is International Women's Month and we are so excited to discuss and learn about important women in history. We always read about women that have paved the way in history, but what about the women in our own lives?

For this project, you will interview a woman in your life that is special and important to you. It can be your mom, grandmother, your friend, your aunt or sister - it can even be someone that was in your family a long time ago!

This project will start off with an interview process. If the person you chose is no longer alive, interview someone who knew them well enough to answer these questions. You will need to ask your interviewee these questions:

- 1. Introduce yourself (name, relation to interviewer).
- 2. Can you think of one significant moment in your life? Explain.
- 3. Why is International Women's Month important?
- 4. Do you have a role model?
- 5. What is something you feel is important for young girls to know?
- → Make sure you are taking notes or typing out the answers!!
- → You will also need to include your personal answer as to why you chose this person.

All of these questions will then be put into a written or typed paper. It will look something like this:

Today I interviewed my mom, Lucy. She is caring, strong and is always willing to lend me a hand. She is a teacher, and that is something I aspire to be when I grow up.

One significant moment in Lucy's life was the day she attended a Woman's March. It was significant because ...

Lucy believes International Women's Month is important because we should celebrate strong women and everything we have accomplished.

You can decide the order of the questions.

Here is a guideline you can use for when you are writing:

Introduction: Your own introduction of the person you are interviewing.

Paragraph 2: In this paragraph, include questions 1 and 2.

Paragraph 3: In this paragraph, include questions 3 and 4

Paragraph 4: In this paragraph, include question 5

Conclusion: Why you chose to interview this person.
